## Private Programs

- Examples include the Bristol-Myers Squibb Assistance Foundation and Rx Outreach

## **Government Assistance Programs**

Government programs typically offer patients prescription medications at a greatly reduced rate.

- · Available to patients who meet program criteria
- Cost of enrollment varies
- Examples include Medicare, Veterans Administration, and state-specific programs

## **Discount Cards**

Prescription-savings cards offer prescription discounts to a broad range of patients.

- Enrollment is quick, easy, and usually free
- Discounts can be up to 75%
- Examples include the PS Card, Together Rx Access, and eSUN Card
